Case Study

We looked at a case study of a resident from one of the Hillingdon houses, via video footage and verbal feedback from the person's support worker.

We discussed the process of getting started using this approach and watched the differences over the months that using this approach has made.

We discussed sustaining practice, recording and sharing progress/ insights with others in the person's life. Between now and next group we will write up learnings to date to become part of the person centred plan and feed this back at the next meeting.

We agreed this was a really useful exercise and that we would invite someone to do another case study at the next meeting.

Trainings

Two trainings in intensive interaction are arranged for next year. Both trainings consist of 4 half day classroom sessions and coaching in the houses in between session. Start dates for the courses are April 10th and Sept 10th 2012.
